Since 2000, the Zonta Club of Washington, D.C. and its charitable arm, The Zonta Club of Washington Foundation, have donated close to \$170,000 to service projects in the District of Columbia and has awarded over \$800,000 in scholarships to more than 170 young women studying in local D.C. universities and medical schools.

The Zonta Club of Washington Foundation, a 501(c)(3) tax- exempt non-profit organization, was founded in 1981 to carry out the charitable objectives of the club, and encourage donors to contribute to support scholarships and service activities of the Zonta Club of Washington, D.C.
